- Card-Type Closures** Compact design with cassette trays for easy fiber insertion and management. Supports multiple core configurations: 12, 24, 48, 72, 96, or 144 fibers. Hot-swappable design allows adding or removing fibers without interrupting service. Three-in-three-out layout improves space utilization and flexibility.

Installation and Maintenance

- Cable Entry:** Each port accommodates cables of varying diameters (typically 10–25 mm) and allows secure fixation.
- Splicing:** Fibers are inserted into trays or cassettes and spliced using fusion or mechanical splicing.
- Sealing:** Closures use mechanical, silicone, or heat-shrink seals to prevent water, dust, and moisture ingress.
- Re-entry:** Many closures support tool-free re-entry, enabling maintenance or network expansion without compromising protection.

- Outdoor aerial networks:** Pole-mounted or suspended installations.
- Underground or manhole networks:** Suitable for underground or manhole installations.
