Portable/Temporary Boxes Designed for indoor and outdoor use, including construction sites, entertainment events, and military applications. Range from

20-800 Amps with adjustable circuit breakers and output ratings. Compact, rugged, and certified to UL standards for safety and durability. Key Components Main Switch/Breaker: Controls the entire supply to the box. Circuit Breakers: Protect individual circuits from overcurrent. Busbars: Distribute power from the main switch to each circuit. Neutral and Earth Bars: Ensure proper grounding and circuit completion.
