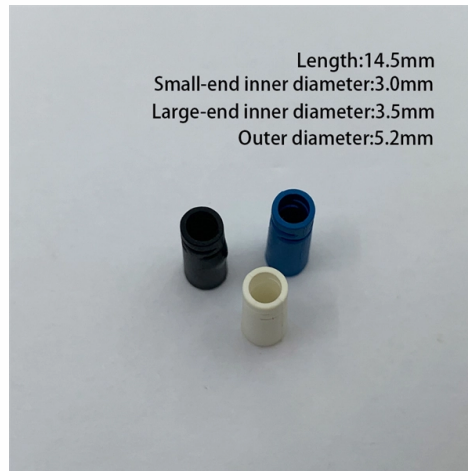


Tips for using fiber optic cables

Use soft Velcro ties or flexible low-voltage conduit to secure cables without crushing them. Pre-terminated cables simplify installation and reduce the risk of signal loss .
