- IK Ratings:** Optional testing for mechanical impact resistance, e.g., IK08, IK10.

- Design Review:** UL engineers evaluate your distribution box design before manufacturing.
- Testing:** Includes electrical safety, environmental exposure, and mechanical impact tests according to the intended Type or IP rating.
- Factory Audit:** UL inspects manufacturing processes to ensure consistent quality and compliance.
- Ongoing Inspections:** Periodic audits maintain the validity of the UL mark.
- Documentation:** Manufacturers must provide detailed component specifications, wiring diagrams, and assembly instructions.
