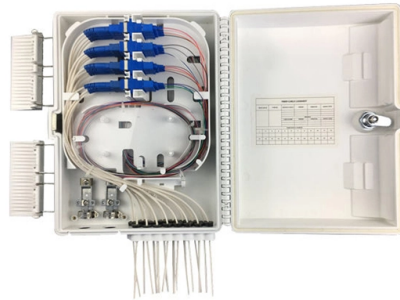

Use industrial-grade plugs for construction environments to prevent accidental disconnection and ensure stable connections. Avoid overloading individual outlets and maintain proper grounding for all devices.

Step 6: Monitor and Maintain Regularly inspect the box and connected equipment for signs of wear, overheating, or damage. Keep the area around the box clear and dry. If any issues arise, disconnect power i...
