Most network cabinets follow the EIA-310 standard with an internal width of 19 inches, which fits nearly all enterprise equipment. Outer widths may vary (e.g., 24", 29.5", 31.5") to allow for cable management and airflow.

Depth Considerations
Depth is critical for equipment fit, cooling, and cable clearance. Common depths include:

- 24" (600 mm): Compact setups, patch panels, or switches.
- 36"-42" (900-1067 mm): Standard for most servers and networking gear.
- 48"-59" (1200-1500 mm): High-density or deep chassis servers.

Cabinet Types
Floor-standing cabinets: Typically 24U-48U, used in data centers and server rooms.
Wall-mounted cabinets: Usually 6U-18U, ideal for SOHO or edge networking.
2-post racks: Lightweight, front-mounted equipment.
4-post racks: Full support for heavy servers and enclosures.

Load Capacity and Cooling
Modern cabinets can support up to 3,000 lbs and require proper airflow management, blanking panels, and cable organization to prevent overheating. Depth and spacing are essential for rear cable clearance and cooling efficiency.
