

What are the dimensions of cable tray support frames

The spacing of supports depends on the tray type and load: ladder trays with heavy cables require closer support spacing than perforated or channel trays to prevent sagging and maintain structural integrity. Typical support spacing ranges from 1.2 m to 3 m, with exact distances determined by manufacturer specifications and load calculations. Load and Safety Factors Support frames must account for cable weight, future expansion, and environmental factors such as vibration, wind, or seismic activity. Proper sizing ensures compliance with NEC, IEC, and NEMA standards, prevents excessive cable stacking, and allows adequate ventilation to avoid overheating.
