Material and Construction The enclosure must be made of robust, non-flammable materials such as stainless steel (Austenitic 304 or higher), aluminum, or GRP, with a minimum wall thickness of 4 mm for mechanical strength and corrosion resistance. All fasteners should be galvanized, and internal components must maintain proper electrical clearance and creepage distances to prevent arcing. Wooden or flammable materials are strictly prohibited due to fire and explosion risks. Wiring and Installation Cables and connectors must be rated for hazardous areas, typically marked with EX or ATEX certification, and resistant to flame, impact, and mechanical damage. Terminal blocks should match the wire cross-section, and all connections must be properly grounded. Wiring should be neatly arranged, tied with nylon tape, and layered distribution boxes should consider trunking for cable entry and exit. Secondary wiring should use black wires with protective casing, and measuring instruments should have enameled conductors. Maintenance and Inspection Explosion-proof switches and enclosures should be inspected at least annually, or more frequently in high-risk areas, to ensure...
