A distribution box should be selected and installed based on load capacity, enclosure material, IP/NEMA rating, wiring standards, grounding, protection devices, and compliance with safety codes.

Enclosure Material and Protection The distribution box enclosure can be made of steel, aluminum, or high-quality plastic such as PVC, polycarbonate (PC), or Acrylonitrile Styrene Acrylate (ASA) depending on the environment. Steel or aluminum is preferred for industrial or outdoor use due to durability, while plastic is suitable for indoor applications. The enclosure should have an IP or NEMA rating appropriate for the location: higher ratings provide better protection against dust, water, and corrosion.

Load Capacity and Circuit Planning Choose a box that matches the total electrical load of the building or facility, with some extra capacity for future expansion. Each circuit should have its own breaker or fuse, and the “one equipment, one switch, one RCD” principle should be followed to ensure safety. For residential setups, main distribution boards (MDB) and sub-distribution boards (SDB) are common, while industrial setups may require motor control centers (MCC) or power distribution units (PDU).

Installation Requirements

- Location:** Install in a dry, well-ventilated, and accessible area close to the power source to reduce losses and ensure safety. Avoid humid, corrosive, or flammable environments unless using explosion-proof boxes.
- Height:** Typically, the bottom edge should be 1.3–1.8 meters above the ground for fixed boxes, and 0.6–1.5 meters for mobile boxes.
- Fixing:** Use firm mounting brackets or screws to prevent tilting or movement due to vibration.
- Spacing:** Maintain proper distances between boxes and equipment: distribution boxes should be within 30 meters of switch boxes, and switch boxes within 3 meters of fixed equipment.
