Power and Cooling Requirements: Racks must accommodate PDUs, fans, and ventilation to ensure proper airflow and prevent overheating. Power limitations may restrict the number of active devices a rack can safely support.

Cable Management: Space for routing and organizing cables is necessary to maintain accessibility and prevent overheating, which can slightly reduce the number of devices a rack can hold.

Practical Example A 42U rack might theoretically hold 42 one-unit servers, but after accounting for PDUs, switches, cable management, and airflow, it typically holds 35–38 devices. Similarly, a smaller 24U rack in a branch office may hold fewer devices due to the same consi...
