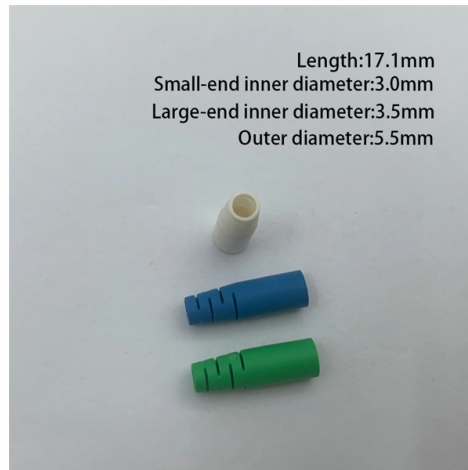


What happens if the optical module receives too much light

One of the most important specifications pertaining to a fiber optic transmission system is the maximum allowable attenuation (or optical loss) it can tolerate from the optical transmitter to the optical receiver. This tends to occur more often when customers are. They convert electrical signals (from your router/switch) into light pulses (for fiber cables) and vice versa. The stronger the signal, the brighter the light.
