This ensures that the optical fibers maintain proper alignment, minimizing attenuation and microbending losses. Compared to non-armored cables, STA cables offer higher crush resistance and impact tolerance, making them suitable for direct burial and campus backbone environments where mechanical stress is significant (Leviton.com), . Material and Construction Steel tape used in fiber optic cables can be stainless steel or electrolytically chrome-coated steel (ECCS), often coated with a thin polymer layer to prevent corrosion.
