Unlike general-purpose servers, AI servers are optimized for massive parallel processing, repeatedly executing the same mathematical operations across enormous datasets. They typically include:

- AI accelerators: GPUs (Graphics Processing Units), NPUs (Neural Processing Units), or TPUs (Tensor Processing Units) that perform parallel computations efficiently.
- High-speed memory: Large amounts of RAM and specialized memory like High Bandwidth Memory (HBM) to handle massive datasets.
- High-speed interconnects: NVLink, PCIe lanes, or other low-latency connections to ensure rapid communication between CPUs and accelerators.
- Optimized storage: NVMe SSDs or other fast storage solutions to prevent bottlenecks during data ingestion.
- Cooling systems: Advanced air or liquid cooling to manage heat from continuous high-intensity processing.

AI servers are used for both training AI models and real-time inference, supporting applications like large language models, image recognition, and predictive analytics. What is AI Networking? AI networking refers to the specialized networking infrastructure that connects AI servers and their accelerators to ensure efficient, low-latency, and synchronized data movement across distributed AI workloads. As AI workloads scale across multiple GPUs or nodes, traditional networks can create congestion, reducing performance. AI networking solves this by:

- Managing data traffic intelligently across GPU clusters.
- Ensuring predictable latency and throughput for training and inference.
- Supporting scale-up architectures (within a single node) and scale-out architectures (across racks or data center pods).
