

What is the appropriate height for a cable tray when climbing a 45-degree slope



Overview

A 10 or 12-foot cable tray is usually used for both of these installation types. Long Span trays are typically supported anywhere from 14 to 20-foot intervals, with 20 -feet being the most popular. Calculate true diagonal travel lengths, horizontal runs, and bend geometry for ladder.
