 - S/FTP (Shielded Foil Twisted Pair) – Each pair is shielded with an overall braid; ideal for high-speed data centers or environments with high EMI.
- Conductor Type:**
 - Solid core – Provides stability and is preferred for permanent installations.
 - Stranded core – Offers flexibility, better for frequent plugging/unplugging near patch panels.
- Jacket Material:**
 - PVC – Standard, flexible, suitable for most indoor applications.
 - LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) – Fire-resistant, emits minimal smoke, ideal for plenum spaces or high-safety areas.
- Connectors:** RJ45 with gold-plated contacts ensures reliable signal transmission and durability. Ensure wiring follows T568A or T568B standards for consistency.
