Visual Fault Locator (VFL): Sends visible red laser light through the fiber to detect breaks, bends, or bad splices. Useful for short-distance links, patch panels, and continuity checks.

Microscope or Inspection Scope: Essential for examining fiber end faces and spliced areas for defects, dust, or scratches that could degrade signal quality.

Cleaning Tools: Fiber optic connections are highly sensitive to contamination. One-click cleaners, lint-free wipes, and alcohol-based solutions help maintain optimal connector performance and reduce troubleshooting time.

Strippers and Utility Knives: Used to remove cable jackets and prepare fibers for splicing. Precision is critical to avoid damaging the delicate glass core.
