Home Installations For residential fiber internet, a fiber drop cable runs from a nearby terminal—either a pole or underground box—to the home. A small box called a Network Interface Device (NID) is installed outside, and the fiber is connected to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) inside or just outside the home. The ONT converts light signals into electrical data for the router, which then distributes internet throughout the home.
