Modern French Fiber Network Today, France maintains a terrestrial fiber optic network that supports broadband and seismic data transmission. The French Fiber Network (FF) collects broadband velocimetric data from DAS instruments and transmits it in real-time via SeedLink protocol . While specific operational base station addresses are not publicly listed, the network spans multiple locations across France, providing high-speed fiber connectivity for research and communication purposes.
