The SFP port is commonly found on Gigabit Ethernet switches and is primarily used for fiber optic device connections or for uplinking 1G switches to aggregation/core layer devices, providing higher-bandwidth links. Never touch the card-edge connectors at the insertion end of the module. Holding the SFP module by its sides, insert the SFP module into the port on the switch. A standard Ethernet cable (Cat5/5e/6/6a cable) is often used when connecting two RJ45 ports on Gigabit switches. 25G SFP28: Designed for 25G data center links.
