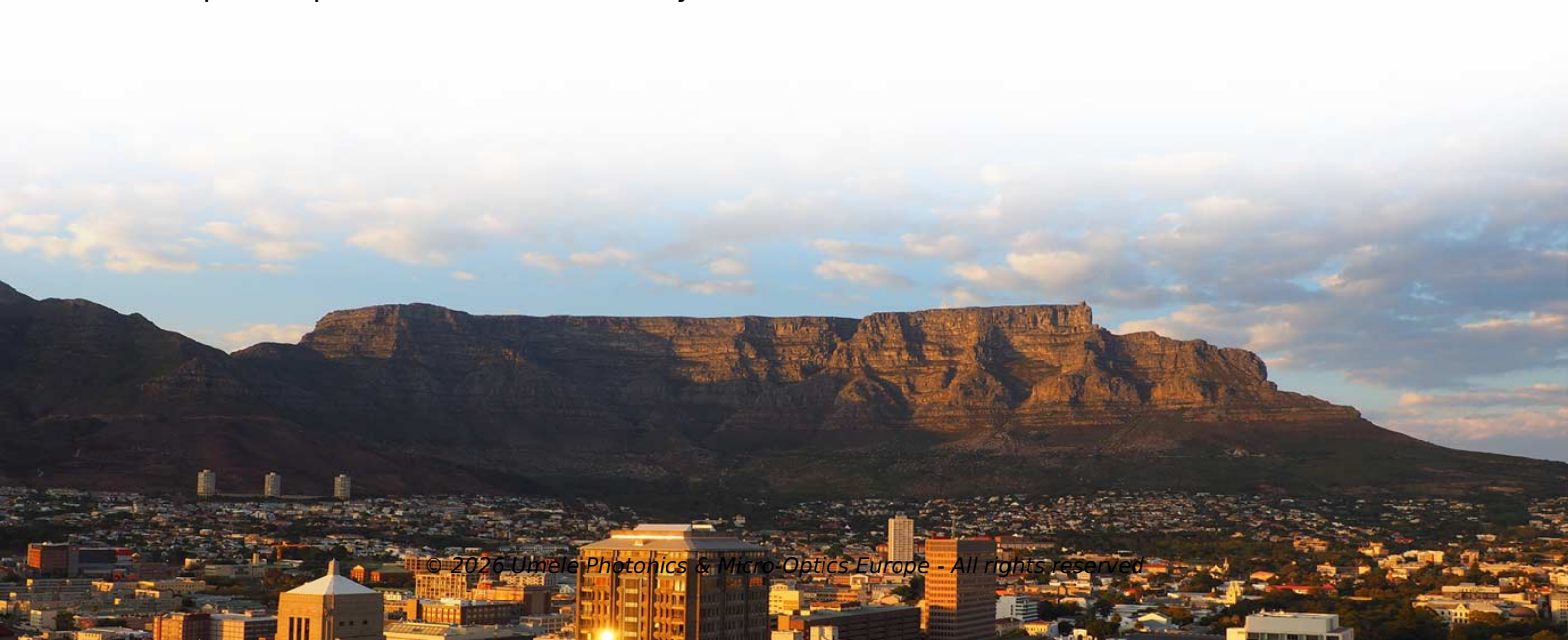


Which way should the door of the secondary distribution box face



Overview

All door openings from substation, electrical rooms, etc. Vertical shutters (like fire rated rolling shutters) may also be acceptable provided they are combined with a single leaf door opening outwards for exit in case of emergency. Designing a substation or switchroom requires careful planning and consideration of various factors to ensure the safety, reliability, and efficiency of the electrical system. The Arrangement order: The circuit breakers should be arranged from left to right, and the reserved position is generally placed on the right side of the distribution box. Wire color: The neutral wire is blue, and the color of the phase wire (A phase is yellow, B phase is green, and C phase is red). - The doors of the distribution room and static compensator enclosures should be reliably connected to the protective conductor using copper core flexible wires with a cross-sectional area not less than 4mm^2 . If the box is wider, the doors can be opened in. These boxes feature bottom entry and exit cables, front-opening doors, and main busbars connected with copper strips for optimal contact.
