Use a multimeter or insulation resistance tester to check for continuity and insulation integrity ().
- 5. Load and Ventilation Assessment** Confirm the distribution box has adequate capacity for the maximum anticipated load, including lighting, power tools, hoists, and cranes (). Ensure proper ventilation and heat dissipation to prevent overheating ().
- 6. Documentation and Maintenance** Record inspection results and any corrective actions. Schedule regular inspections: visual checks every 1–3 months and comprehensive maintenance ever...
