- Busbars:** Separate bars for neutral and earth connections, ensuring organized and safe wiring ().

Wiring Codes and Standards

- Phase (Live) Wire:** Typically red, brown, or black depending on local standards. Connects to the input of MCBs or DP switch.
- Neutral Wire:** Typically blue or black. Connects to the neutral busbar and then to the MCBs as required.
- Earth Wire:** Green/yellow striped. Connects to the earth busbar for grounding all metallic parts ().

Wire Sizing: Must comply with load requirements and breaker ratings. Overloading wires can cause overheating and fire hazards ().

Voltage Considerations: Single-phase domestic supply is usually 230V AC (India, Europe) or 110-120V AC (USA). Three-phase systems are used in industrial or high-load applications ().

Installation Guidelines

- Install the box in a dry, accessible location at a height of ~1.5 meters for easy operation ().
- Ensure proper IP/NEMA rating for protection against dust and moisture, especially for outdoor or industrial setups ().
- Maintain neat cable management and secure all connections to prevent short circuits ().
- Label all circuit...
