- Grounding and Safety Protection** The metal enclosure, electrical installation board, and appliance casings must be reliably grounded. A protective neutral wire should be connected through a terminal board. Leakage protectors (RCDs) are recommended to provide additional protection against electric shock.
- Industrial Connectors and Plugs** Standard household plugs are not suitable for construction sites. Industrial plug sockets and CEE connectors are used to handle heavy equipment, repeated use, and outdoor conditions. Outdoor connectors should meet IP67 protection to resist dust and water ingress.
- Temporary vs Permanent Wiring** Temporary wiring is designed to be flexible, relocatable, and resistant to environmental hazards such as rain, dust...
