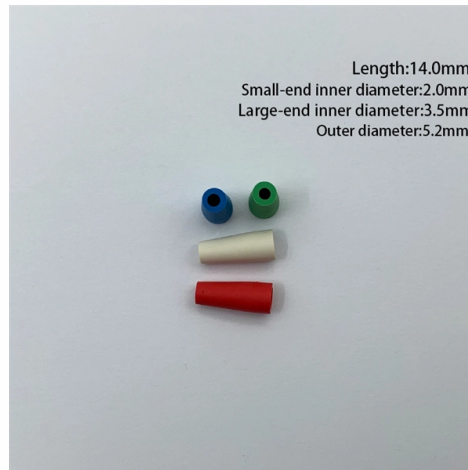


Working principle of fiber optic unit sensor

A fiber optic sensor measures a physical quantity by modulating the intensity, spectrum, phase, or polarization of light traveling through the optical fiber system. It's a device that converts light rays into electronic signals. In remote sensing, fibers play a key role but based on the requirement, fibers may be used.
